SUBJECT: Cancellation of Department of Energy Standard 1190-2007, Illness and Injury Surveillance Program Guidelines

The Office of Worker Safety and Health Policy (AU-11) is proposing to cancel and archive Department of Energy (DOE) Standard (STD) 1190-2007, *Illness and Injury Surveillance Program Guidelines*, and submits this proposal for review and comment in accordance with Technical Standards Program (TSP) procedures.

The Illness and Injury Surveillance Program, managed under the Office of Domestic and International Health Studies (AU-13), was de-funded in Fiscal Year 2012, and AU-1 has determined that the program will not be revived. DOE-STD-1190-2007, *Illness and Injury Surveillance Program Guidelines*, was specific to the Illness and Injury Surveillance Program. No other programs are affected by, or use, this voluntary consensus standard.
