SUBJECT: Proposed Cancellation of Department of Energy
Standard 6005-2001

The Office of Worker Safety and Health Policy submits for review and comment in the RevCom for Technical Standards Program (TSP) the cancellation of the following standard:

DOE-STD-6005-2001, *Industrial Hygiene Practices*

This standard is being proposed for cancellation because its content has been superseded by requirements and guidance in:

- Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, part 851, *Worker Safety and Health Program*, February 9, 2006;
- Department of Energy (DOE) Order 440.1B, *Worker Protection Program for DOE (Including the National Nuclear Security Administration) Federal Employees*, June 17, 2011; and
- DOE Guide 440.1B, *Worker Protection Program for DOE (Including the National Nuclear Security Administration) Federal and Contractor Employees*, October 20, 2011.
