DOE has a long history of working with the VCS community to develop standards that help DOE achieve its mission with regard to the safety, security, design, operations, and maintenance of its facilities. Where appropriate, VCSs are referenced or invoked in our directives or contracts as the means to meeting our specific requirements.

In accordance with the 2016 Office of Management and Budget (OMB) Report data call, the DOE Technical Standards Program (TSP) asked for input from all DOE organizations. Although the 2016 OMB report is not asking for the level of detail requested in previous years, DOE will continue to collect data in the manner it has in the past. DOE believes that collecting this data is important for trending, as well as for being able to ascertain how organizations use VCSs.
